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UNINJA Provides Laptops for More Than Bootstraps High School Fellows

PASSAIC, NEW JERSEY – October 23, 2020 - **More Than Bootstraps** (<u>MTB</u>), a New Jersey nonprofit, has partnered with another non-profit organization, the **Union Innovation NJ Alliance** (<u>UNINJA</u>), to provide laptops for six students in the Passaic, New Jersey, Public Schools. The students are participants in a near-peer mentoring program created to help first-generation, low-income students access and succeed in higher education.

MTB was established by a group of educators seeking to level the playing field and remove some of the substantial barriers encountered by first-generation students. UNINJA provides free or low-cost devices to fight the digital divide and technical support in order to democratize computation. This particular donation was supported by **Ben Derman** and **Temple Emanu-El of Westfield**.

Mike Saxon, co-founder of UNINJA, said: "UNINJA is proud to support More than Bootstraps in helping first-generation students succeed in their journey to and through higher education." Saxon explained that "providing tech access to these students aligns perfectly with our mission to provide free or low-cost computing devices to families who cannot afford them, as well as to help those families set up and maintain those devices."

In addition to the laptop computers, students in the MTB program receive monthly stipends and access to emergency resources to help them with the many non-tuition expenses of higher education. "The assistance provided by UNINJA is critical. The digital divide is a critical issue in educational inequality; COVID and online instruction have exacerbated the challenges firstgeneration students face," said Audrey Fisch, president of More Than Bootstraps.
